

MOD spends £405 k on Common Purpose phoney cultural projects.

There were 400,000 complaints about housing from Army families in 2006/7. During the same period, MPs warned that 19,000 homes out of the 70,000 married quarters and 165,000 single "living spaces" were in disrepair.

Defence bosses splashed out £230million on hotels and dinners - while spending £16million upgrading the squalid houses of squaddies
