1. A red pin in a rural area equates to between 1 and 10 people (approx).
2. A red pin in a major city or urban area equates to 200 people (approx).
3. A red pin in the London area equates to 500 people (approx).

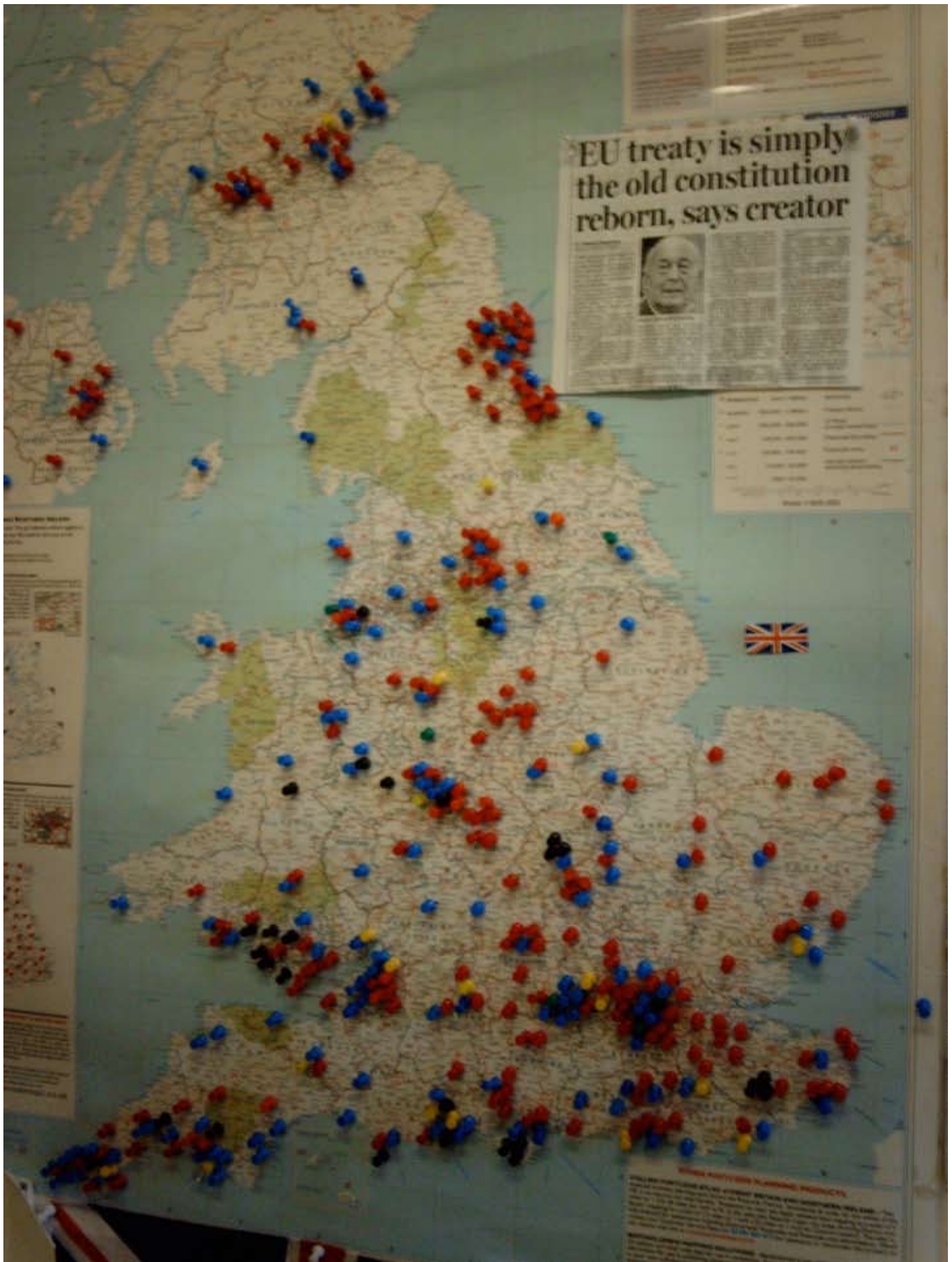
The geographical spread is a guide. It is indicative and being updated, however the map serves the purpose of showing the scale of CP's infiltration into our society.
